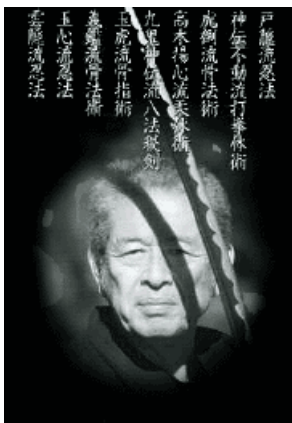


Why Train in Bujinkan Budo Taijutsu?

Training in Bujinkan Budo Taijutsu offers the student (deshi) a complete martial art. During training, the deshi may learn techniques in ground fighting, grappling, striking, kicking, and throwing. Additionally, as the deshi progresses he/she will train in the use of various weapons like the katana, short sword, bo staff, half bo staff, and many others. However, training does not emphasize physical skills alone.

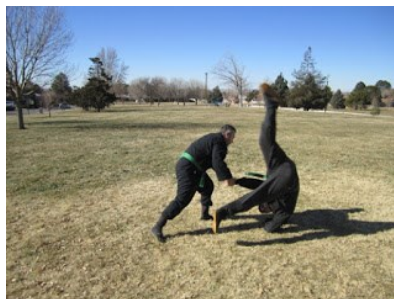

History of the Fudo Myo Dojo

The Bujinkan (Warrior Spirit Trainin Hall) is the banner for the system of martial arts headed by Soke Dr. Masaaki Hatsumi. It is composed of nine different schools or families of martial arts. The Bujinkan Yamaneko Dojo (Warrior Spirit Mountain Cat Training Hall) was founded by 15th Dan Jeff Prather. The Bujinkan Yamaneko Fudo Myo Dojo (Warrior Spirit Mountain Cat Immoveable Spirit Training Hall) was founded in 2006 as an official branch of the Yamaneko Dojo.

History and Tradition of the Bujinkan

The Bujinkan Budo Taijutsu system is composed of nine different traditions called ryu-ha or families. Each ryu-ha specializing in different areas of budo. The nine ryu-ha are:

Togakure-ryū Ninpō Taijutsu (戸隠流忍法体術)
Gyokko ryū Kosshijutsu (玉虎流骨指術)
Kuki Shinden Happō Bikenjutsu (九鬼神伝流八法秘剣術)
Koto Ryū Koppōjutsu (虎倒流骨法術)
Shinden Fudo Ryū Dakentaijutsu (神伝不動流打拳体術)
Takagi Yoshin Ryū Jūtaijutsu (高木揚心流柔体術)
Gikan Ryū Koppōjutsu (義鑑流骨法術)
Gyokushin-ryū Ryū Ninpō (玉心流忍法)
Kumogakure Ryū Ninpō (雲隠流忍法)

Additional Information

The Fudo Myo Dojo is an official branch of the Bujinkan Yamaneko Dojo located in Tucson Arizona and has been so for ten years. Prior to founding the Fudo Myo Dojo, I was head of the Bujinkan Yamaneko Dojo Socorro Branch training at New Mexico Insitute of Mining and Technology.
